

Coast & Beaches

1. **Breakwater Restaurant:** 15582 WA-112, Clallam Bay
Good burgers, fish, steaks and more with a great view.
2. **Makah Museum:** 1880 Bayview Ave, Neah Bay
2 hrs. from B&B. Pick up Recreational Use Permit \$10.
Museum entry \$5. Exhibits, artifacts, recreation of long house.
3. **Linda's Woodfired Kitchen:** 1110 Bayview Ave, Neah Bay
1 mile from museum. Authentic woodfire pizza & fresh fish.
4. **Cape Flattery:** Northwest-most point of contiguous U.S.A.
9 miles (20 min.) past museum. Stay on road with double yellow line to the end and park. 3/4 mile moderate hike to overlook. View of Pacific, Tatoosh Island & lighthouse.
5. **Hobuck Beach:** Returning from Cape Flattery via Cape Loop Rd, follow signs for Hobuck Beach Resort.
6. **Ozette Triangle Trailhead:** Enter via Ozette Ranger Station:
2 hrs. 10 min. from B&B. Nat'l Park Pass required.
Hike three 3-mile legs through forest and along the beach.
7. **Hungry Bear Cafe:** 1 hr. 10 min. from B&B with no delays.
Not many places to eat around here. This is one.
8. **Twilight Tours in Forks & Twilight Museum:**
Rainforest Arts Center 35 and 51 N Forks Ave, Forks
1 hr. 30 min. from B&B. Twilight fans, this is the place.
9. **Three River's Restaurant:** 7764 La Push Rd, Forks
Good burgers any werewolf would love.
10. **Rialto Beach:** 1 hr. 45 min. from B&B with no delays.
1 hr. 30 min. from Neah Bay. 101 South to 110 West,
turn right onto Mora Rd. Parking at the beach. Hike north
along beach to see Hole-In-The-Wall & rock formations.
11. **River's Edge Restaurant:** 41 La Push Rd, Forks
Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner with a view to the water.
12. **Hoh Rainforest Visitor Ctr:** 18113 Upper Hoh Rd, Forks
2 hr. 15 min from B&B with no delays. Nat'l Park Pass
required. Temperate rainforest with 300 ft. tall Sitka spruce,
hemlock & fir, unique moss & lichen. Roosevelt Elk possible.
